

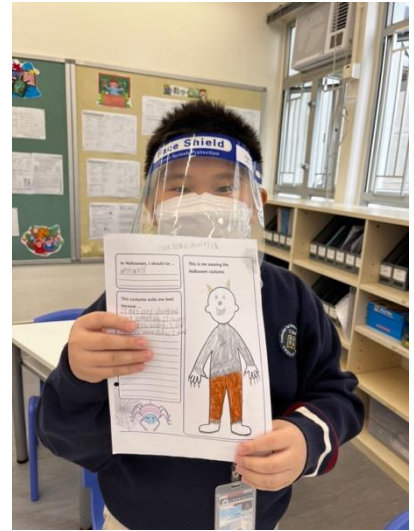
Happy Halloween Party—4J Chow Zhengle Eason

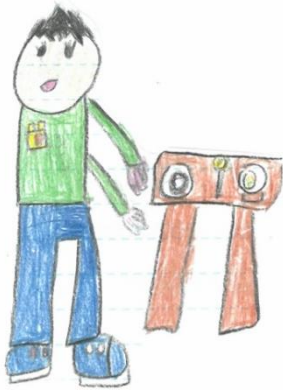


that day, too. We could get cookies and popcorns after we did the tongue twister challenge.
